How to arrive at the WWF office in Frankfurt

By train

Frankfurt's main train station is literally around the corner. Take the exit „Stadtmitte“ (city centre) and walk straight ahead, across the street and after approx. 100 metres you will find our office on the left-hand side.

By car

Please bear in mind that there are no free parking spaces next to our office. You may use the parking spaces at the main train station where charges apply.

By plane

Local trains arrive and depart from the regional train station at Terminal 1. The city centre (main train station) can be reached with the local trains "S-Bahn" S8 and S9 in only 11 minutes. Take the exit „Stadtmitte“ (city centre) at the main train station and walk straight ahead, across the street and after approx. 100 metres you will find our office on the left-hand side.

By taxi

Taxis are available at all times in front of all airport terminals. A ride from/to Frankfurt City Centre costs roundabout 25 € and takes approx.. 20 to 30 minutes – depending on traffic.
